You have several options for equipment service. Below is the most common equipment service provider used by UCSB divers along with instructions on how to utilize their services. BCD's, computers, regulators, and Air2s also **require an annual inspection**. You can sign up for an upcoming gear inspection through Webdiver > Training Courses > Equipment Inspection.

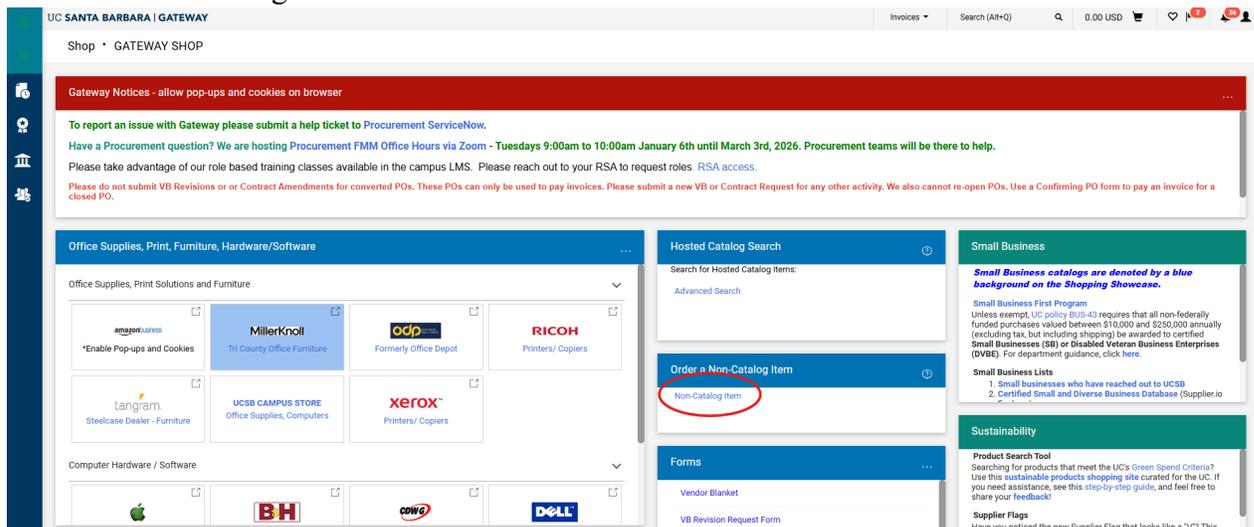
Steps for Sending Gear to Scuba Solutions through EH&S

Paying out of pocket (not through a grant/lab):

1. Contact [Josh at Scuba Solutions](#) informing him you would like to get your gear serviced
 - Call or text: 805-870-5545
 - Email: info@scubasolutionsca.com
2. Coordinate payment
3. Once you have informed Josh and coordinated payment, you can schedule a day and time to drop off your gear with Darrin Ambat (dambat@ucsb.edu) at the EH&S Dive Locker.
 - Gear is picked up every Tuesday and dropped off the Tuesday following its service.
 - This option is provided by Scuba Solutions for free!

Paying using grant/lab funding (purchase order (PO) in Gateway):

1. Select "non-catalog item"
